Please only purchase blue or black pens as they are the easiest to read and the farthest away from red. This makes my life much easier when correcting.

Expandable files can be found at Target or Walmart, or probably any place that they sell school supplies. I realize they are a little bit more expensive than traditional folders, but I find them to be much more durable and much harder to lose things from. I have also been able to keep mine around for many years so hopefully this is a onetime expense.
